

Rules

1. To be run under Pony Club Guidelines (see PC website)
2. Open to all Pony Club branches and centres
3. Rider's ages as of 1 January 2024
4. All ponies must be aged 5 or older
5. No pony may be ridden by more than one person in any one class
6. For reasons of safety, no cantering other than in warm up areas and competition rings
7. All competitors must wear a protective helmet, manufactured to one of the minimum standards listed in the Pony Club Hat Rule 2024 at all times when mounted with the chin straps fastened. **All hats must be tagged with a Pink Pony Club, Riding Club or BE hat tag. Tagging will be available on the day.**
8. The decision of the judge is final
9. The organisers reserve the right to disqualify anyone for misuse of whip or spurs, dangerous riding or any horse or pony in poor or lame condition
10. Horses/Ponies must not be left unattended, **especially never left unsupervised tied to the outside of trailers and lorries**
11. Only the competitor may ride the horse on the day at the event
12. The Organiser's decision is final
13. All ponies must be compliant with the current Pony Club minimum vaccination requirements (see <https://pcuk.org/officials/rulebooks/>). Spot checks may be done

Dress Code: All competitors must wear correct rally dress. Stirrups should be of the correct size to suit the rider's boots and must have 7mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ ") clearance on either side of the boot.

Health and Safety Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.

STRICTLY NO DOGS

SHOWING (Entry £5 per class)

Start - 9.30am

CLASS 1a - STYLE AND APPEARANCE - Lead Rein / assisted (any age)

CLASS 1b - STYLE AND APPEARANCE - 8 years and under

CLASS 1c - STYLE AND APPEARANCE - Over 8 years

CLASS 1d - RIDDEN VETERAN - Ponies 20 years and above

CLASS 1e - FANCY DRESS

Championship class

Competitors may only enter ONE Style and Appearance class.

1st and 2nd place from classes 1a - 1d will go through to a showing championship class that will follow class 1e.

For classes 1a – 1d competitors will be expected to perform a simple show of walk, trot and canter on both reins. Canter is option for lead rein / assisted.

SHOWJUMPING (Entry £5 per class)

Start - 10.30am

All classes are single phase – competitors jump one course of jumps
And the second half of the course will be timed

CLASS 2a - Poles and crosses - Lead rein / assisted (any age)

CLASS 2b - Poles and crosses

CLASS 2c - 40cm - Lead rein / assisted (any age)

CLASS 2d - 40cm

CLASS 2e - 50cm

CLASS 2f - 60 cm

CLASS 2g - 70cm

CLASS 2h - Pairs (Max height 40cm - may be lead rein / assisted)

CLASS 2i - Pairs (Max height 60cm)

CLASS 2j - Ride and run (Max height 40cm - may be lead rein / assisted)

CLASS 2k - Ride and run (Max height 60cm)

For classes 2h and 2i, riders will jump half the course each, with the first rider passing a whip to the second rider.

For classes 2j and 2k, riders will jump half the course then dismount and run the second half of the course on foot.

OBSTACLE COURSE (Entry £3 per class)

Riders can take part at any time before 1pm - classes running simultaneously.

CLASS 3a - Lead Rein / assisted (any age)

CLASS 3b - 8 years and under

CLASS 3c - Over 8 years

These classes are against the clock and will include a number of obstacles - some to be negotiated mounted and some unmounted.

MOUNTED GAMES (Entry £10 per class)

Start - Afternoon

CLASS 4a – Lead Rein / assisted (any age)

CLASS 4b – 8 years and under

CLASS 4c – Over 8 years

Each Group to take part in 5 games – Bending, Mug, Ball and bucket, Flag, Ride and run.

CHASE ME CHARLIE (Entry £2 per class)

Start - Afternoon

CLASS 5a - Lead Rein / assisted (any age)

CLASS 5b - 8 years and under

CLASS 5c - Over 8 years

CLEAR ROUND JUMPING (Entry £2 per round)

Start- 9.30am

Fences may be adjusted to any height up to 70cm
